

Map & Directions to #1 Murray Hill Drive / Entrance #2



Link to enlarged & printable version of the map and text below.

#1 Murray Hill Drive is the "DSS (Department of Social Services) Building." In the main photo above, Building #1 is the small yellow rectangle in the center right. From this aerial view, you see it is actually a complex of buildings. If you put "1 Murray Hill Drive, Mt. Morris, NY" in your navigation app, your final turn will be onto Murray Hill Drive. The blue line in the photo above traces Murray Hill Drive to the parking lot at the back of Building #1. In the enlarged photo in the bottom left of the image above, locate Entrance #2 in an orange circle. There is also an orange line tracing one of several paved sidewalks from the Parking Area to Entrance #2. (Entrances #1 and #3 will be closed and locked.) The Parking Area has been outlined in yellow. Overflow parking is available to the right and left of the marked Parking area.

There are two handicap parking spaces marked on the map. There is also a curbside drop-off point at the tip of the orange arrow. From the drop-off point, the walk to Entrance #2 is about 50 yards.
