House Budget Bill Opposed by Livingston County, or Is It?

In Livingston County, at least, we have not heard a Town Supervisor, or the Board of Supervisors collectively, go on the record criticizing the House of Representatives Budget Bill or Representative Claudia Tenney (NY-24), who voted for the bill.

However, Livingston County is a member of the New York Association of Counties (NYSAC), which on May 21, 2025 issued a press release titled, New York County Leaders Urge Congressional Delegation to Reject Devastating Cuts to Medicaid and SNAP in House Budget Bill. In addition, NYSAC offers a Stand Up for NY Toolkit, including a Fact Sheet, Talking Points, Sample Letter to the Editor, and Sample Social Media Posts.

In the week since this Toolkit was published, I have not seen or heard about it in Livingston County media or in the halls of the Government Center. If I missed something, please let me know.
